Advisory board introduction, mentorship sessions, and guest lectures from both new and experienced board members. Inspiration and knowledge to seek out advisory board opportunities.

**4<sup>th</sup> Meeting: Innovation & Future Leadership** September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

Inspire innovative thinking and prepare participants for leadership roles in sustainability (In current positions in companies or for startups). Innovation labs, pitch sessions for sustainability solutions, leadership development workshops.
